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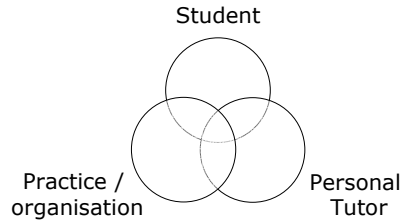
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Context

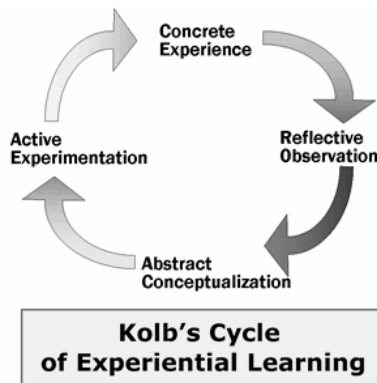

Storyboard

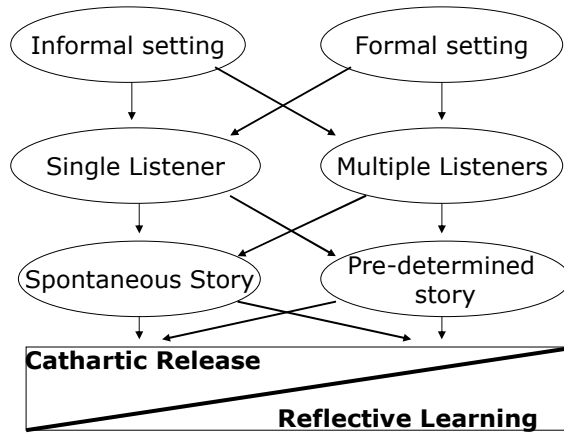
A way of knowing.....

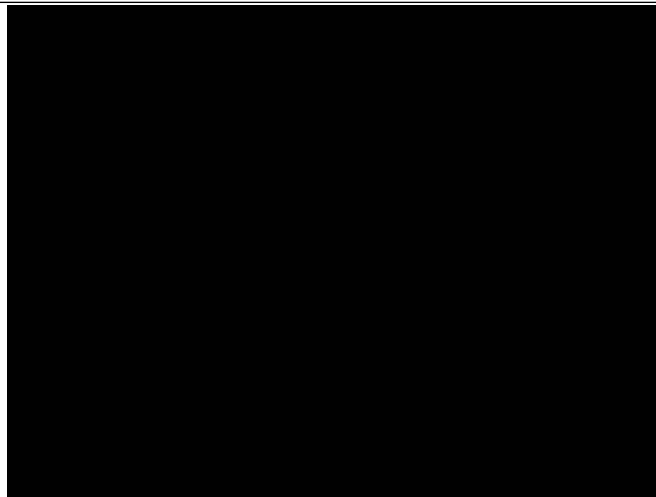
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Their Storyboards

Critical Questions

- Is the use of imagery, art and storytelling to construct a Personal Development Storyboard more likely to illicit a 'true-voice' of personal professional developmental reflection?
- Is the self concealed and protected by the Storyboard?
- Does the use of imagery, art and storytelling facilitate higher critical reflective thinking skills?
- Does each sequence of the storyboard provide an explicit reference point for future reflection?



Evaluation: What they said



Written evaluation

- *'they have identified changes over time..... some of these issues were not initially identified until the reflection process was performed and images developed and reviewed'*
- *'I believe it is a quick method of reflection that can be fun compared to others'*
- *'I feel the images are a recollection of feelings at a particular time, it doesn't necessarily reflect particular events'*
